At the request of Doctor Bisquertt, I am forwarding printed information concerning the general plan of fellowships in the Mayo Foundation.

Our facilities are being taxed to the utmost to meet our commitments to fellows of the Foundation who have been on leaves of absence for military service and who are now returning. How long this condition will exist depends, of course, upon the rate of demobilization, but we do not anticipate any number of vacancies during 1947.

We are doing everything we can for those who visit the Clinic to observe the work that is going on in the field in which they are interested, and should you come to the United States we will be glad to have you visit Rochester. I must call your attention, however, to the acute housing situation here and urge you to make hotel reservations before arrival.
